The hospital I delivered our beautiful babies at, Lehigh Valley Hospital, located in Allentown, PA provided us with two blue and one pink teddy bear from your foundation after delivery. We initially didn't know what to think of the teddy bears, however upon arriving home they have become the only shred of comfort we have found— having something to hold and cry with has proven to be more meaningful than we could have ever imagined, and we have the Brianna Lee Foundation to thank for that.
