Today I'm feeling the need to share my thoughts and feelings. I haven't decided if I will do this from time to time here or if I will start a blog, but it's important and helps me to talk about Jase and this experience. Don't be afraid to talk to me or to bring up his name, yes I may cry (my baby died!), but the tears and emotions are always there, you're not bringing them up. It's your choice to read or scroll past...

It's been one month. Where has the time gone? The memorial service has passed, I picked up Jase's urn this week, the 'dust' from it all is settling. Now what? Trying to figure out how to move forward. Grieving...reality and emotions are hitting me hard.

Reading a blog today, I read a post from a friend that lost her child last August, she wrote:

"The absolute worst tragedy parents can imagine is the loss of their child. You hear of other families that lost a child and can't help but imagine yourself in that position; and the thought is always "I would never be able to handle that". I, too, had those same thoughts when hearing of other children who have died. It is something you imagine but never EVER think you would one day be in that position. Sometimes I cannot believe that I am the one that people are thinking of when shaking their head and saying "I could never do it".

How did we get here? Why were we chosen to endure this?

No matter how terrible and how painful you imagine the tragedy, it is a hundred times worse... a thousand times worse.... a million times worse." - Starr M.

Today these words she wrote are speaking to me. It's true. I NEVER EVER thought I would be in this position. The hurt and pain is a million times worse than you can imagine! I ask myself daily why us? You prepare for so many months to have your baby and in one night it all changes...hopes and dreams shattered and gone. Your life changes, then you have to figure out how to navigate the grief that is so intense.

As we continue to grieve I am thankful for our family and friends. Your outpouring of love has been amazing. We've received some sort of message whether it be a card, FB message or text daily, I am so appreciative for those words & will continue to be. Sometimes its something so simple that makes me tear up, smile or just feel the love. Your love, support and prayers remind us we are not alone in this journey.
